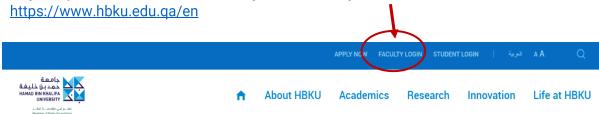

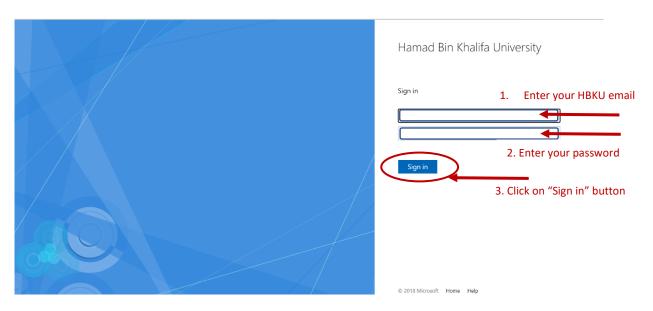

1- Login to your BANNER account through the following link:

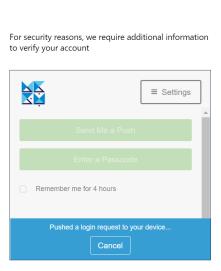


2- The link will direct you to the following screen to enter your BANNER credentials (username and password), then press on "Sign In" button.



3- You will be directed to the following screen and at the same time, you will receive a notification on your registered mobile phone to approve the access.

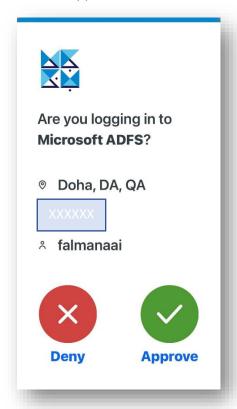




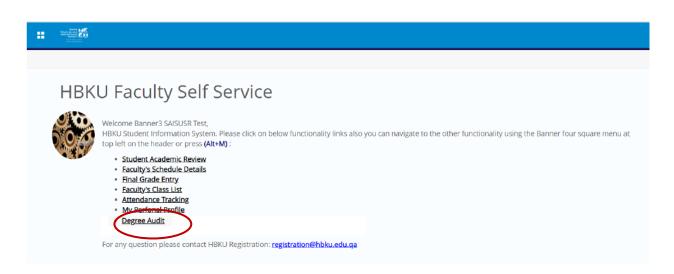

Press on "Approve" to be able to access your BANNER account.



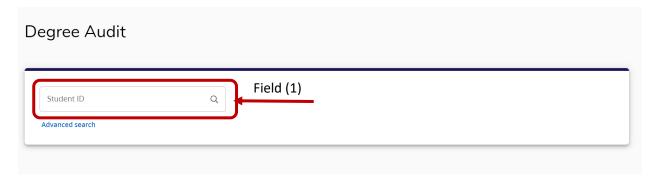
4- Select "Degree Audit" option on your Banner account home page.



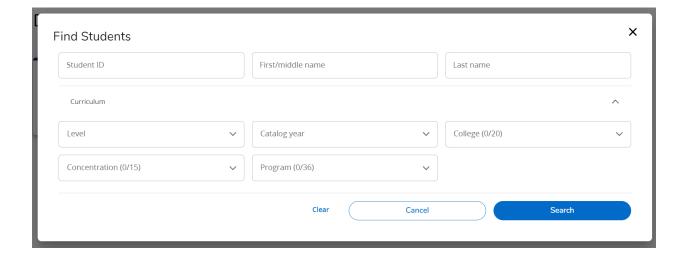


5- If you want to get the degree audit for a specific student and you already know the HBKU student ID number, please enter it in the field number (1).

If you want to get the degree audit for a list of students, or you don't have the HBKU student number, click on "Advanced search".

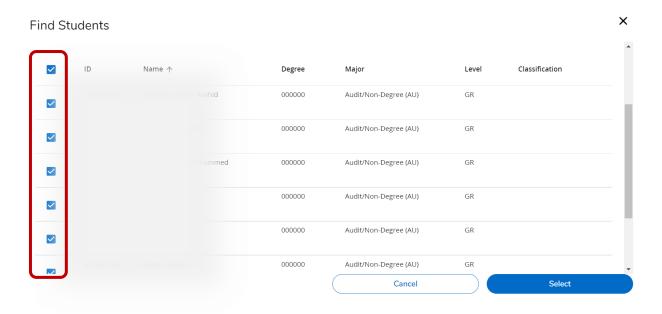


You will get the following screen for "Advanced Search". Enter/ select the required parameters to search for the either a specific student or for a list of students. Then press on "Search".

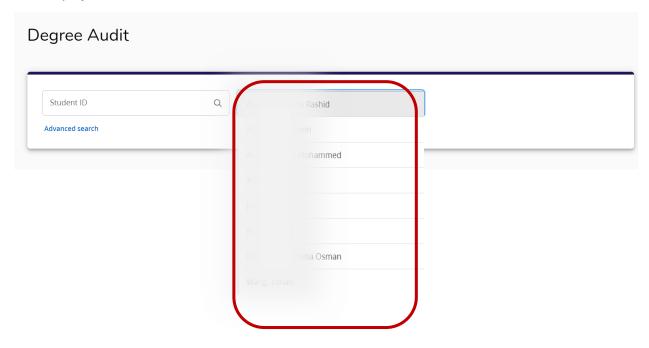




6- You will get a list of students as shown. You can select either one student or a list of students by checking the small boxes on the left side. Then press on "Select".



7- You will get the following screen to select a specific student and get his/her degree audit page.

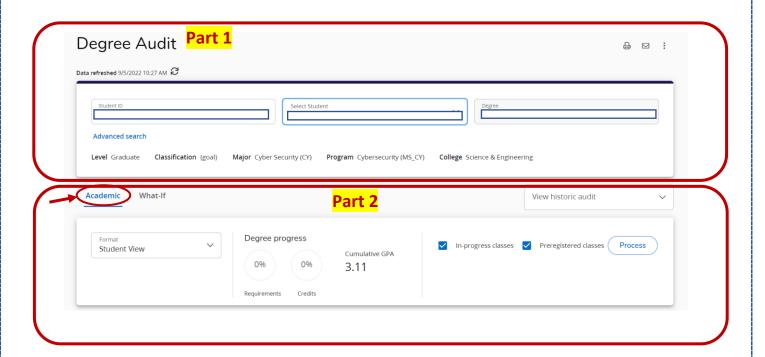




8- The <u>Student Header</u> provides useful information includes the <u>first part</u>: the student's HBKU ID, full name, degree, level, classification (set for Undergraduate level only) major, program, college and concentration.

The <u>second part</u> (<u>under Academic</u>) gives you an audit in line with current catalog year to:

- Determine what HBKU requirements that student needs to fulfill in order to complete his/her degree.
- Identify what requirements student has completed according to his/her study plan.
- View individual course grades, cumulative grade-point average (CGPA), and the number of earned credits
- Determine which courses student has have taken or transferred, that count toward his/her degree.
- View transfer credits, substitution, and exceptions applied toward student's degree.
- See the courses in progress.
- View the unused courses completed but not counted towards student's degree completion.



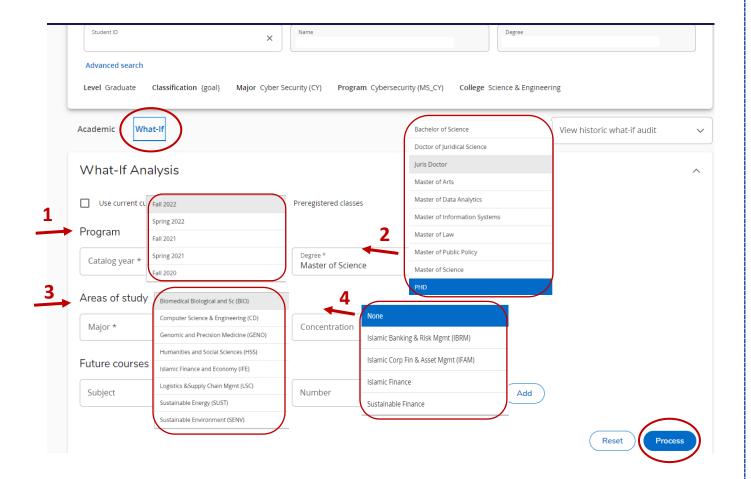
9- Scroll down the student's degree audit, to view more details about the following: student's catalog year, completed courses, not completed courses, in progress courses, the not used courses and in-sufficient and audit courses.

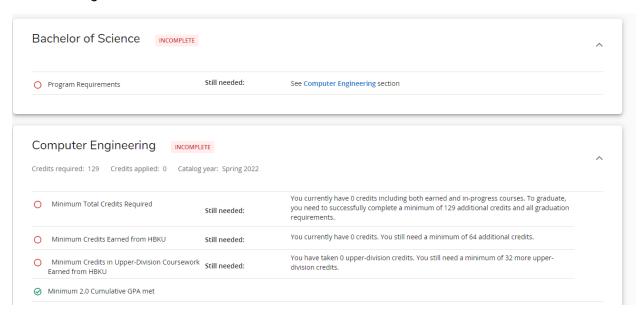
10- The "What-If", function allows student and advisor to hypothetically change the major, concentration or catalog year.

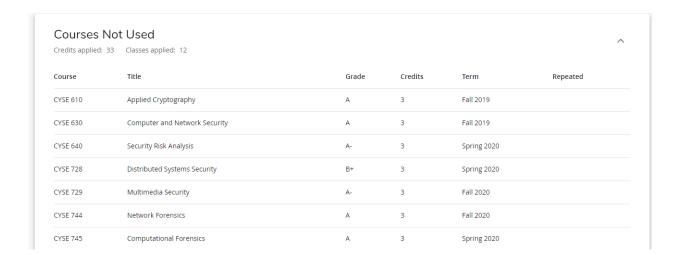
The What If audit will show what coursework is required for the new major, concentration or different catalogue year of the same program, what courses your students have taken that satisfy requirements, and what courses are still left to be taken. Select: 1. catalog year / 2. Degree / 3. Areas of study / 4. Concentration (if any) → then press on "Process".



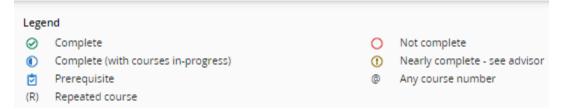


11- You will get the details for the used/ not used courses as shown:





Here are some notes for more clarifications about student's courses:

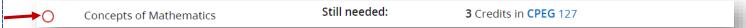




- The green checked course means the course is already completed and graded. See the following example.



- The red empty circle means the course is not taken yet and the student has to complete it. See the following example.



 The half-filled circle with blue color means the course is in-progress and once the current semester is finished and the student passes the course, it will be changed to a green checked course (completed).
See the following example.



- The blue checked square means: prerequisite course. See the following example.



- The insufficient courses include the courses: with grades: D/ F / W /Au (audit).

The repeated courses can be noticed by (R) on the right side. See the following example.
